

Window and Door Vendor Price Announcements

The ongoing significant rise of raw material costs in conjunction with material shortages, extended lead times, global supply chain disruptions, and increasing transportation costs have impacted the building materials industry. As a result, the following window and door manufacturers whose products we offer at our supply centers have announced upcoming price increases:

- **Waudena** has announced a price increase of approximately 3-10% on all Waudena Entrance Systems, Garage Clad Kits and Sliding Patio Doors. We will adjust our prices effective with shipments on 5/1/2021.
- **Lumbermen's** has announced a price increase of approximately 6-12% on all Therma-Tru and Simpson Entry Door Systems. We will adjust our prices effective with shipments on 5/3/2021.
- **Reeb** has announced a price increase of approximately 5.5-6.5% on all Interior Prehung and Exterior Prehung Doors. We will adjust our prices effective with shipments on 6/1/2021.

Reeb has announced a price increase of approximately 7-10% on all Therma-Tru, RSP primed and imported, Woodgrain and Simpson doors. We will adjust our prices effective with shipments on 7/1/2021.

- **Larson** has announced a price increase of approximately 7% on all Storm Doors, Storm Windows and Retractable Screens. We will adjust our prices effective with shipments on 6/1/2021.
- **Ben Bilt** has announced a price increase of approximately 10-14% on all Exterior Steel and Fiberglass Doors. We will adjust our prices effective with shipments on 6/7/2021.
- **Huttig** has announced a price increase of approximately 9-14% on all Exterior Steel and Fiberglass Doors; Interior Flush and Molded Doors; Stile and Rail Doors. We will adjust our prices effective with shipments on 6/7/2021.
